Olivier Barbier has been active in the French film industry since 2012. Initially, he was active as Sales Executive at Wild Bunch International. Finally, he took over the position of Head of Acquisitions at the renowned international sales powerhouse mk2 films. Here he was responsible, among others, for the acquisition of the films PORTRAIT OF A LADY ON FIRE, THE WORST PERSON IN THE WORLD, PETITE MAMAN, ALCARRÀS and CORSAGE.

Vanja Kaludjercic is festival director of the International Film Festival Rotterdam (IFFR) since 2020. Kaludjercic has over 20 years of industry experience, both on an international level and within the Dutch film landscape. The IFFR is one of the strongest and largest public festivals in the world, as well as an unmissable date in the international festival calendar. Prior to her position as Head of IFFR, she was Director of Acquisitions at MUBI and held key positions at Les Arcs European Film Festival, Sarajevo Film Festival, Netherlands Film Festival (NFF) and IFFR, where she established the IFFR Talks & Masterclasses from 2016 to 2018. Julien Rejl is a graduate of the renowned La Fémis cadre. Between 2010 and 2020, he was responsible for distribution and acquisitions at the world sales company Capricci. In this context, he worked with directors such as Abel Ferrara, Hong Sangsoo, Albert Serra, Wang Bing, Tsaï Ming-Liang and Philippe Garrel. Julien Rejl initiated the theatrical release of numerous restored masterpieces of film history including films by Jean-Luc Godard, Kenji Mizoguchi, Ingmar Bergman, Maurice Pialat, David Lynch and David Cronenberg. He worked as a film critic and writer and took over the programming of the Sofilm Festival between 2015 and 2019. In June 2022, he was entrusted with the artistic direction of the Cannes Director's Fortnight.

Saralisa Volm, filmmaker, author, actress and producer founded the production company POISON in 2014. Among others, she produced the film FIKKEFUCHS (directed by Jan Henrik Stahlberg), which was successfully released in German cinemas in 2017. She has already published several books and celebrated the world premiere of her feature film debut SCHWEIGEND STEHT DER WALD (THE SILENT FOREST) at the Berlinale 2022 which was priorly presented at EWIP 2021. Thanassis Karathanos (TWENTY TWENTY VISION in Berlin, PALLAS FILM in Halle(Saale)) is a successful international film producer. He produced films by Olivier Assayas (CLOUDS OF SILS MARIA), Bruno Dumont (MA LOUTE), Paul Verhoeven (ELLE) and Elia Suleiman (IT MUST BE HEAVEN), among others. Two of the films he produced, THE MAN WHO SOLD HIS SKIN and AJAMI, were Oscar® nominated. His most recent productions, THE GRAVEDIGGER'S WIFE and MARIUPOLIS, celebrated their world premieres in the official selection of the Cannes International Film Festival in 2021 and 2022. He was the only German to be invited as an Oscar®-Academy member in 2022.

In 2007, he moved to Paris where he collaborated with Jayro Bustamante on two short films and as first assistant director on the film TEMBLORES. Since 2013. Juan is a recognized editor of French TV with more than 40 documentaries to his credit. ALMAMULA is his first fiction project (Eurimages Development Prize, San Sebastián FF 2019). As a preamble to the story of his film, he directed and produced his short films SACHA and MACO (2019) his home town Santiago del Estero.





DESERTS is a modern western drawing a kaleidoscopic portrait of Morrocan society.

Longtime friends. Mehdi and Hamid travel the region on behalf of a debt collection agency, crisscrossing the south Moroccan countryside, mountains and desert in their old car. Their clients are the poorest of the poor, living in small villages and old mining towns with lifeless streets. Mehdi and Hamid are generally given a hostile reception and they struggle to extract their debts from the bad payers. Paid nearly nothing themselves, they play hard to make good figures. One day, in a gas station planted in the middle of the desert, a motorcycle parks in front of them, with a man handcuffed to the luggage rack. SYNOPSIS

Dozens of teenage monks live in the Buddhist temples of Luang Prabang in Laos. One of them reads the Bardo Thodol to an old woman, a text that should be read to people before they die, as it provides orientation in the afterlife. The woman dies and we accompany her spirit on a sensory journey until she is reincarnated in her next body. We thus enter the bardo, the place of transit in the Buddhist conception. The experience becomes introspective, close to meditation: the screen is filled with light and colour. devoid of images, in a passage of the film meant to be experienced with closed eves, a passage led by sound. When the image returns to the screen, the story is set in a Tanzanian coastal village, following the woman's spirit in a goat that will grow up in the company of a fishing family.

Challenging everyone's vision, she starts to imagine the earthquake as a "friend" who has forced her to live outdoors and brought the community together, creating a visionary game she becomes more and more involved in...

After a few shorts and documentaries. Federico Bondi wrote and directed his first feature film MAR NFRO in 2008, which was the only Italian film in competition at the 61st Locarno International Film Festival, where it won three awards (Golden Leopard for Best Actress. Ecumenical Jury Award, Young Jury Award). The film was nominated to the "David di Donatello" Awards (Best Actress) and Federico Bondi was nominated at the Silver Ribbon Awards as Best New Director. In 2019 his second feature film DAFNE participated in the 69th Berlinale in the Panorama section winning the prestigious FIPRESCI Award. The film was also awarded with a Special Silver Ribbon and nominated at the European Film Awards 2019 as Best Feature Film. Federico Bondi has also directed many advertisements and documentaries including: SOSTE (2001), SOSTE JAPAN (2002) and EDUCAZIONE AFFETTIVA (2014).



As a teenager, Efrat Anne Tilma was threatened by a police officer in Tel-Aviv who told her that if he sees her walking the streets in women's clothes again, he will drown her in the sea. She fled the country, made a name for herself as a lip-sync artist in Europe, spent a month in a male prison in Belgium, and finally saved up enough money to travel on her own to Casablanca and undergo sexual reassignment surgery. After the surgery Efrat vowed never to reveal her full story to anyone. She landed her dream job as a flight attendant, got married, and led a guiet life in Berlin for over 20 years. Now in her seventies, she returns to Israel to seek recognition, claim the respect she deserves and spend the last chapter of her life in the country she once had to flee.

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
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TFL COMING SOON
